WE ARE OPEN BY APPOINTMENT!

The Library is currently open by appointment only. 45-minute appointments are available Monday - Saturday at 10:00, 11:00, 3:00, 4:00 and 5:00. We welcome up to seven households at a time. Patrons may schedule an appointment once every seven days. To schedule an appointment, visit our website or call 479-750-8180.

Requirements for Entry

- Patrons over the age of 10 must wear a mask. Masks must be worn over the mouth and nose at all times while in the building. Disposable masks are available free of charge.
- Patrons must maintain six feet of social distance from other patrons and library staff.
- We ask that patrons limit appointments to once a week per household.
- Appointments are limited to Library cardholders. Patrons can register for a Library card by visiting our website.
- Patrons under the age of 11 must be actively supervised by an adult guardian at all times.

The Springdale Public Library offers curbside pickup for Library patrons.

- Patrons may request up to 5 titles per pickup. Pickups are available from 10-12 and 3-5:45. Staff will confirm your titles are available.

kanopy

Kanopy is an on-demand streaming film service and offers a broad selection of documentaries, classic films, foreign language films and training videos from PBS, BBC, The Great Courses and more. Patrons have eight play credits per month plus unlimited viewing in Kanopy Kids.

freegal music

Freegal Music is a free online music service where you can download and/or stream music on any compatible device. Browse through a vast collection of over 15+ million songs from over 200+ genres.
